STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Kentucky Welding Institute is committed to providing accurate, accessible, and timely information to enrolled and prospective students so they can make well-informed decisions about their education, financial aid options, and campus safety.

Each year, KWI distributes a notice to all enrolled students regarding the availability of institutional information required under federal regulations. This includes information provided in the following general categories:

- General institutional disclosures for enrolled and prospective students
- Annual Security Report and Annual Fire Safety Report (Clery Act compliance)
- Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) information, outlining student rights and the protection of education records

Method of Disclosure

Kentucky Welding Institute provides notification of the availability of this information to each student upon completion of the enrollment and admissions process and annually thereafter. Printed copies of any policy or report may also be requested from the Student Services office.
